

## **Paid and Unpaid Museum Internship Programs Available to Undergraduate Students**

It is possible to gain a volunteer internship at almost any arts institution, however, the following institutions have paid and unpaid internship programs, which usually provide students with a more structured introduction to museum studies and professional opportunities. Most of these programs have deadlines for application, usually in December and January of each year, so be sure to check the deadlines early. These applications will often require a recommendation, essay, and other submissions, so plan accordingly. Paid opportunities vary from year to year depending on institutional funding. Be sure to check the museum's website for current information.
